2. NOTHING HAPPENS UNTIL _____

Jesus said, “Unless a grain of wheat is buried in the ground, it cannot reproduce. But if it dies, it will produce much fruit.” John 12:24

Jesus said, “The kingdom of God is like someone who plants seed in the ground. Night and day, whether the person is asleep or awake, the seed still grows, but the person does not know how it grows.” Mark 4:26-27 (NCV)

3. WHEN I HAVE A NEED _____

“Do your planting in the morning and in the evening, too! You never know whether it will all grow well or whether one planting will do better than the other.” Ecclesiastes 11:6 (TEV)

4. WHATEVER I PLANT _____

“You will reap exactly what you plant.” Galatians 6:7b (TEV)

8. I ALWAYS REAP _____

“Some seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, MULTIPLYING thirty, sixty, and even a hundred times.” Mark 4:8

9. I INCREASE MY HARVEST _____

“Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will reap generously. Each one should give what he’s decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.” 2 Corinthians 9:6-7
