Nehemiah 1:11-2:9

STEP 1: _____

“O Lord, please hear my prayer! And listen to the prayers of all your servants who love to honor you. Give your servant success today by granting him favor in the king's presence.’ In those days I was the king's wine steward.” Nehemiah 1:11

STEP 2: _____

“Four months later, when King Artaxerxes was dining, I took the wine to him.” Nehemiah 2:1

“The king replied to me, ‘Well, what is it you want?’ Then I prayed again to the God of heaven.” Nehemiah 2:4

STEP 4: _____

“After praying I answered, ‘If it pleases Your Majesty and if your servant has found favor in your sight, send me to the city in Judah where my ancestors are buried so that I can rebuild it.” Nehemiah 2:5

STEP 5: _____

“Then the king, with the queen sitting beside him, asked, ‘How long will your work take, and when will you get back?’ The king was willing to send me so I set a time!” Nehemiah 2:6

STEP 6: _____

“Then I asked the king to give me letters for the governors of territories west of the Euphrates river, giving me safe travel to Judah. I also asked for a letter to the keeper of the king's royal forests, instructing him to supply me with the timber I needed to rebuild the gates of the city, the city walls, and for a house to live in.”

- They used RESISTANCE (Nehemiah 4:7-8, 10)
- They used RUMORS (Nehemiah 4:12)

HOW PEOPLE WILL TRY TO STOP YOU WITH RIDICULE

1. PEOPLE WILL _____

"When Sanballat heard we were rebuilding the wall, he became very angry. He flew into a rage and ridiculed the Jews. To his allies and the military of Samaria he said, 'What does this pathetic bunch of feeble Jews think they're doing?'"

Nehemiah 4:1-2

2. PEOPLE WILL _____

"They said, 'What are you doing? Are you rebellng against the king?'"

Nehemiah 2:19 (NCV)

"Are they going to restore it for themselves?" Nehemiah 4:2 (NAS)

3. PEOPLE WILL _____

"When Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arab heard of our plan, they made fun of us and laughed at us." Nehemiah 2:19 (NCV)

"When Sanballat, Tobiah, the Arabs, the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites heard the repairs had started, they were very angry and plotted together . . . to stir up trouble against us." Nehemiah 4:7-8

4. PEOPLE WILL _____

"Those who want to hurt me plan trouble for me; All day long they think up lies . . . They repay me with evil for the good I've done, and they lie about me because I try to do good." Psalm 38:12, 20 (NCV)

"Do they think they'll finish the wall in a day and then offer sacrifices to their god?"

5. PEOPLE WILL _____

HOW SHOULD I HANDLE RIDICULE AND INSULTS?

1. _____
"So I prayed: 'God, you can hear how they are making fun of us. Let their insults just fall back on their own heads and may they themselves become captives in a foreign land! Don't ignore their guilt, because they have thrown insults in the face of the builders.'" Nehemiah 4:4-5

2. **CONFIDENTLY STATE** _____
"I answered them, 'The God of heaven WILL give us success. We are his servants and we will start rebuilding!'" Nehemiah 2:20 (NIV)

"Arrogant people mock me cruelly, but I do not turn away from your teachings!"

3. **BE BETTER** _____
"Dear friends, never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God. For it is written, 'I'll take vengeance and I'll repay those who deserve it,' says the Lord. Instead, do what the Scriptures say: 'If your enemies are hungry, feed them. If they're thirsty, give them something to drink, and they'll be ashamed of what they've done to you.' Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good." Romans 12:19-21 (NLT/NIV)

WHEN YOU FEEL LIKE GIVING UP

“The people quickly rebuilt the first half of the wall around Jerusalem until it reached HALF ITS HEIGHT, because they worked hard with all their heart. BUT THEN (our enemies) heard how Jerusalem’s walls were being repaired and all the gaps were being closed. They became very angry and plotted to attack Jerusalem together and create some confusion to stop the progress. So we prayed to God for protection and posted 24 hour guards to protect the workers. But then people began to complain. They said, ‘We’re tired and worn out! Besides that there’s so much rubble and trash to be removed. We now realize that we cannot finish this wall.’ Also our enemies are now threatening us. They’re saying, ‘Before you know it or even see us, we’ll be among you to kill you and end your work!’ Then, those who lived closest to our enemies kept reporting—over ten times—that our enemies kept saying, ‘We’re going to attack you from every direction!’” Nehemiah 4:6-12

4 CAUSES OF DISCOURAGEMENT

1. “Then the people of Judah began to complain that the workers were becoming tired.” Nehemiah 4:10 (NLT)

“Never forget how the Amalekites . . . attacked you when you were exhausted and weary, and they struck down those who began to lag behind.” Deuteronomy 25:17-18 (NLT)

2. “Besides that, there was so much rubble and trash to be removed.” Nehemiah 4:10

3. “We now realize that we CANNOT finish this wall!” Nehemiah 4:10 (NAB)

“We’ll NEVER be able to finish it!” Nehemiah 4:10

4. “Also our enemies are now threatening us. They’re saying, ‘Before you know it or even see us, we’ll be among you to kill you and end your work!’” Nehemiah 4:11

“Then, those who lived closest to our enemies kept reporting—over ten times—that our enemies kept saying, ‘We’re going to attack you from every direction!’” Nehemiah 4:12

HOW CAN I DEFEAT DISCOURAGEMENT?

1. “You made my body Lord – now give me sense to heed your laws.”
Psalm 119:73 (TLB)

“It is useless for you to work so hard from early morning until late at night, anxiously working for food to eat; for God gives rest to his loved ones.”
Psalm 127:2 (NLT)

2. “So I stationed armed guards at the most vulnerable points of the wall and at the most exposed places I assigned people by families to protect each other with their swords, spears, and bows.” Nehemiah 4:13 (The Message)

“Some people have gotten out of the habit of meeting together with other believers, but we must not do that! Instead, we should keep on encouraging each other.” Hebrews 10:25 (CEV)

3. “Aware of their anxiety, I stood up and said to the nobles, officials, and the rest of the people, ‘DO NOT BE AFRAID of the enemy! REMEMBER THE LORD who is great and awe-inspiring!’” Nehemiah 4:14 (NJB)

"You'll earn the trust and RESPECT of others IF you work for good."

"About this time, some of the people, both men and their wives, began to complain loudly against their Jewish brothers." Nehemiah 5:1

CAUSES OF CONFLICT (Nehemiah 5:1-5)

1. WHEN _____

"Some said, 'We all have large families, and WE NEED more grain to eat to stay alive.'" Nehemiah 5:2 (GNT)

2. WHEN WE FEEL _____

"Others said, 'We've had to sell our fields, and vineyard, and houses just to keep from starving during this famine.'" Nehemiah 5:3 (GNT)

3. WHEN LEADERS _____

"Others said, 'We've had to borrow money to pay the king's taxes.'" Nehemiah 5:4 (GNT)

4. WHEN WE FEEL _____

"Although we're the same flesh and blood as our wealthier countrymen and though our children are as good as theirs, we're having to sell our children into slavery! Some of our daughters have already been enslaved, but we're powerless to do anything about it because our fields and vineyards belong to others!" Nehemiah 5:5 (NIV)

WAYS TO EARN THE RESPECT OF OTHERS (Nehemiah 5:6-13)

1. _____ OF OTHERS

Nehemiah: *"When I heard their complaints and their charges, I was very angry."*
Nehemiah 5:6 (NIV)

"Be angry, and yet do not sin." Ephesians 4:26 (NASB)

"Jesus was angry as he looked at the people, for he was deeply disturbed by their indifference to human need." Mark 3:5 (NCV/TLB)

2. _____ BEFORE I SPEAK UP

Nehemiah: *"Then after I thought it over."* Nehemiah 5:7 (GW)

"I pondered the charges in my mind." Nehemiah 5:7 (NIV)

"After some deliberation." Nehemiah 5:7 (NJB)

"The godly think before speaking, but wicked people quickly spout evil words without ever thinking." Proverbs 15:28 (NLT)

"Remember this: You must always be quick to listen, but slow to speak and slow to become angry, because human anger cannot accomplish the righteousness of God." James 1:19-20 (GNT)

3. TRY TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS _____

Nehemiah: *"After thinking about the problem, I confronted the leaders and officials, challenging their actions. I said, 'You are oppressing your own countrymen with interest!' THEN I called a public assembly to deal with the problem."* Nehemiah 5:7 (GNT)

Jesus: *"If your brother sins against you, go to him privately to point out his fault . . . If he doesn't listen to you, then go back with one or two witnesses . . . If he still refuses to listen, go public with the whole church."* Matthew 18:15-17 (GNT)

4. APPEAL TO _____

Nehemiah's Challenge: Nehemiah 5:8-13

"What you're doing is wrong! We must honor God by the way we live so that Gentiles can't find fault with us." Nehemiah 5:9 (CEV)

"If your goals are good, you'll be respected." Proverbs 11:27 (GNT)

5. DO EVERYTHING WITH _____

Nehemiah: *"For the 12 years I was governor, neither I, nor my team, ate the food entitled to the governor. The previous governors before me had placed heavy burdens of taxation on the people to pay for this. Even their assistants took advantage of people but I never did that. Out of reverence for God I did not act like they did. Instead, I devoted myself to working on the wall and so did all my men. None of us acquired any land. Also, I paid the cost of 150 people who daily ate at my table along with many foreign guests . . . In spite of all this, I never demanded what was due to me as governor, because the people were having a difficult time. So, remember me with favor, O my God, for all I've done for these people."* Nehemiah 5:14-19
