## Session 1: How We're Getting Through

**PARTS 1-2** 

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of all compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others with the same comfort that we've received from God.

For just as the sufferings of Christ flow over into our lives, so also through Christ our comfort overflows. If we're distressed, it's for your salvation; and if we're comforted, it's for your comfort...

OUR HOPE for you IS FIRM, BECAUSE WE KNOW that just as you've shared in our sufferings, so also you will share in our comfort.

We don't want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about the hardships we've suffered... We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired even of life itself. Indeed, in our hearts we felt the sentence of death.

But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead. He HAS delivered us... and we've set our hope on him that he WILL CONTINUE to deliver us, as you help us by your prayers. Then many will give thanks to God for the gracious favor granted to us in answer to your many prayers."

### • OUR REAL STRUGGLE \_\_\_\_\_

### JACOB'S WRESTLING MATCH

"Jacob sent his family across the Jabbok River but he stayed behind, alone. That night, a Man came and wrestled with him until daybreak. When the Man saw that he wasn't winning the struggle, he hit Jacob on the hip, and it was thrown out of joint. The Man said, 'Let me go; daylight is coming.' Jacob said, 'I WON'T LET GO UNTIL YOU BLESS ME.' The Man asked 'What is your name?' 'Jacob,' he replied. The Man said, 'Your name will no longer be Jacob. You have STRUGGLED WITH GOD and with men, and you have WON; so your name will be ISRAEL.'

> Jacob = "deceiver/manipulator" Israel = "struggled with God /Prince with God"

Then God blessed him there. So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, 'It is because I saw God face to face, and yet my life was spared."" GENESIS 32:23-30

### HOW TO WRESTLE WITH GOD AND GET BLESSED

### SURRENDER

David's Loss of a Child – 2 Samuel 12:16-24

Then on the seventh day the baby died. David's advisers were afraid to tell him. 'He was so broken up about the baby being sick,' they said. 'What will he do to himself when we tell him the child is dead?' But when David saw them whispering, he realized what had happened. 'Is the baby dead?' he asked. 'Yes,' they replied." **2 SAM. 12:16-19 (NIT)** 

### **STEPS OF SURRENDER**

### "David said, 'I fasted and wept while the child was alive, for I thought perhaps the Lord would be gracious and let the child live. But why should I fast when he is dead? Can I bring him back again?" 2 SAM. 12:22-23 (NLT)

### PAIN CAN BE USED FOR A GOOD PURPOSE
