1. NO CONDEMNATION: _____

“There is now no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.”

2. NO DOMINATION: _____

“Through Christ Jesus, the law of the Spirit of Life has set me free from the law of sin and death.”

“The Law of Moses could not save us, because of our sinful nature. But God put into effect a different plan to save us. God destroyed sin’s control over us by giving His Son as a sacrifice for our sins.”

“Those dominated by their sinful nature think about sinful things, but those controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please God... If the Holy Spirit controls your mind, there is life and peace.”

3. NO TERMINATION: _____
