FIVE BENEFITS OF A CHURCH FAMILY

1. A CHURCH HELPS ME MY LIFE AROUND GOD.

"You were planned for God's pleasure."

"Christ's love has the first and last word in everything we do. Our firm decision is to work from this focused center ... "

2 CORINTHIANS 5:14 (MES)

"It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life." PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7 (MES)

THE BIBLE CALLS THIS:

"You have six days to do your work, but the seventh day of each week is holy because it belongs to Me. No matter where you live, you must rest and come together for worship." LEVITICUS 23:3 (CEV)

2. A CHURCH HELPS ME ______ WITH OTHER BELIEVERS.

HOW CAN I JOIN THIS CHURCH FAMILY?

1. Choose to belong! CLASS 101: Discovering Membership

2. Show your commitment by baptism.

"This is what we proclaimed in word and action when we were <u>baptized</u>. Each of us is now a <u>part of his resurrection Body</u>." 1 CORINTHIANS 12:13 (MES)

"That's what baptism into the life of Jesus means. When we are lowered into the water, it is like the burial of Jesus; when we are raised up out of the water, it is like the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus."

3. A CHURCH HELPS ME ______SPIRITUAL MATURITY.

"You were created to become like Christ."

"Christ's Body is fitted together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, <u>it helps the other parts grow</u>, so that the whole Body is <u>healthy and growing</u> and full of love." EPHESIANS 4:16 (NLT)
