Story of the Shrewd Manager: Luke 16:1-13

Jesus said, "There once was a rich man who enlisted a manager to take care of his property. But the manager was accused of wasting his master's possessions, so the Owner called him in and said, 'You must now give me an account of your stewardship and report what you've done with what I entrusted to you because your time as a manager is ending!'
