WHAT DID JESUS “FINISH” ON THE CROSS?

1. HE _____

“The law of Moses could not save us, because of our sinful nature. But God put into effect a different plan to save us. He sent his own Son in a human body like ours . . . and gave his Son as a sacrifice for our sins. God did this so that the requirement of the law would be fully accomplished FOR us . . .”
