5 Bible Metaphors

1. IN GOD'S FAMILY: ______

"You are members of God's very own family... and <u>you belong</u> in God's household with every other Christian."

EPHESIANS 2:19 (LB)

"Jesus and the people he makes holy <u>all belong to the same family</u>. That is why he isn't ashamed to call them his brothers and sisters."

HEBREWS 2:11 (CEV)

2. IN GOD'S TEMPLE: _____

"In Christ the whole building <u>is joined together</u> and rises to become <u>a holy</u> <u>temple</u> in the Lord. And in him you too are <u>being built together</u> to become <u>a</u> <u>dwelling</u> in which God lives by his Spirit."

"I want us to help each other with the faith we have. Your faith will help me, and my faith will help you."

3. IN CHRIST'S BODY: _____

"Just as there are many parts to our bodies, so it is with <u>Christ's Body</u>. We are all parts of it, and <u>it takes every one of us</u> to make it complete, for we each have different work to do. So <u>we belong to each other</u>, and <u>each of us needs</u> <u>all the others</u>."
