"For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability."

o RADICAL GENEROSITY IS
" <u>Of their own free</u> will they begged us and pleaded for the privilege of having a part in
helping God's people in Judea." 2 Corinthians 8:3b-4 (TEV)

THE RESULTS OF RADICAL GENEROSITY
1. IT
"Just as you excel in everything elsein faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for ussee that you also excel in the grace of giving. I am not commanding you, but I want to test the <u>sincerity of your love</u> by comparing it with the earnestness of others." 2 Corinthians 8:7-8 (NIV)
"Your heart will be where your treasure is." Matthew 6:21 (NCV)
2. IT
"You are familiar with the generosity of our Master, Jesus Christ. Rich as he was, he gave it all away for us—in one stroke he became poor and we became rich." 2 Corinthians 8:9 (MSG)
3. IT
"Remember this: Whoever sows snaringly will also rean snaringly and whoever sows

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also <u>reap generously</u>... for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work." 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (NIV)
