MESSAGE 4: SEEING WHAT GOD WANTS ME TO SEE Parts 1-3

ILLUMINATION: Letting the Holy Spirit show me the meaning of God's Word and how it applies to my life

MESSAGE 5: HOW TO STUDY A BIBLE PASSAGE Parts 1-4

The key to Bible Study is asking good questions.

PHILIPPIANS 2:19-30

"I hope in the Lord Jesus to send <u>Timothy</u> to you soon, that I also may be cheered when I receive news about you. <u>I have no one else like him</u>, who <u>takes a genuine interest</u> in your welfare. For everyone else looks out for his own interests, not those of Jesus Christ. But you know that Timothy <u>has proved himself</u>, because as a son with his father he has served with me in the work of the gospel. I hope, therefore, to send him as soon as I see how things go with me. And I am confident in the Lord that I myself will come soon. But I think it is necessary to send back to you <u>Epaphroditus</u>, <u>my brother</u>, fellow worker and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger, whom you sent to take care of my needs. For he <u>longs for all of you and is distressed</u> because you heard he was ill. Indeed <u>he was ill</u>, and almost died. But God had mercy on him, and not on him only but also on me, to spare me sorrow upon sorrow. Therefore I am all the more eager to send him, so that when you see him again you may be glad and I may have less anxiety. <u>Welcome him</u> in the Lord <u>with great joy</u>, and <u>honor men like</u> <u>him</u>, because he almost died for the work of Christ, <u>risking his life</u> to make up for the help you could not give me."

(TEV) "<u>genuinely cares</u> for you ... others <u>only care about themselves</u>" (Ph) "...they are all wrapped up in their own affairs..."

MESSAGE 6: UNDERSTANDING THE MEANING OF A TEXT Parts 1-4

Observation: What does it say? Interpretation: What does it mean? Correlation: What other verses explain it? Application: What will I DO about it?

JOHN 15:1-17

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no FRUIT, while every branch that does bear FRUIT he prunes so that it will be even more FRUITFUL. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear <u>FRUIT</u> by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear FRUIT unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much FRUIT; apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much FRUIT, showing yourselves to be my disciples. As the Father has LOVED me, so have I LOVED you. Now remain in my LOVE. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my LOVE, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his LOVE. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. My command is this: LOVE each other as I have LOVED you. Greater LOVE has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear <u>FRUIT</u>- <u>FRUIT</u> that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. This is my command: LOVE each other."

PROBLEM VERSE:

Vs. 6 "If anyone doesn't remain in me, he's like a branch that's thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned."

"Love" = mentioned 9 times "Fruit" = mentioned 9 times "Fruit" & "Fruitful" = 45 times in New Testament What is meaning of "fruit" <u>in this context</u>?

Vs. 4 "<u>Remain in me</u>, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it <u>must remain</u> in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you <u>remain in me</u>." John 15:4 (NIV)


