"You might have to suffer even when it is unfair, but if you think of God and stand in the pain, God is pleased... Remember, Christ suffered FOR YOU and gave us AN <u>EXAMPLE TO FOLLOW</u>. So you should do as he did." 1 Peter 2:19, 21(NCV)

"That Sunday evening, the disciples were <u>huddled together in a home</u>, with the <u>doors locked for fear</u> of the authorities. <u>Suddenly Jesus appeared</u> standing there among them. They were frightened so Jesus said, "Peace be with you!" Then he showed them the nail scars in his hands and where he'd been pierced in his side. At that point everything changed. The disciples were overwhelmed with joy when they realized that it really was the Lord!" John 20:19-20

ON FRIDAY: DAYS OF FEAR & PAIN

1. I NEED TO REACH OUT

"Jesus took his disciples with him to Gethsemane and said, <u>Stay here with me</u> while I pray.' Then he took Peter, James, and John a little further. He was <u>filled with anguish and deep distress</u>, and he said to them, 'My heart is <u>so</u> <u>overwhelmed</u> and <u>crushed with sorrow</u> that I feel like I'm dying. <u>Just sit here and watch with me</u>.' Then Jesus took a few more steps, fell to the ground and prayed..." Matthew 26:36-39

"Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you fulfill the law of Christ." Galatians 6:2

2. I NEED TO REACH OUT

"Jesus fell face down on the ground and prayed that if possible, he would not have to suffer the pain ahead of him. He prayed, "Abba! Father! I know you can do all things. And I don't want to have to drink this cup of suffering. Nevertheless, I want your will, not mine, to be done." Mark 14:35-36

3 THINGS TO PRAY

- Affirm God's power: I know_you can do anything!
- Express your desire: I don't want this pain!
- Offer your trust: I want your will, not mine

ON SATURDAY: DAYS OF CONFUSION & GRIEF

"Then Jesus told them, 'Before the night's over, you're going to <u>fall to pieces</u> because of what happens to me."" Matthew 26:31 (Mes)

"At that point, all the disciples <u>abandoned Jesus</u> and <u>ran away</u>." Matthew 26:56

3. I NEED TO REMEMBER

Jesus said, "Here's what's going to happen: Soon I'll be gone and you'll be without me, but after a while, you'll see me again...You will weep and mourn and grieve...but your <u>grief will eventually turn into joy</u>. It will be like a woman going through labor pains. When her child is finally born, her <u>anguish turns to joy</u> because the new life wipes out the memory of the pain. In the same way, you'll go through sorrow now, but I'll be back and you will rejoice; and no one will be able to rob you of <u>that joy</u>!" John 16:16, 20-22
