

MESSAGE 2: WHAT TO DO WHEN IT FEELS HOPELESS

Parts 1-4

7 STEPS FROM JONAH 2:1-10

"From inside the fish <u>Jonah prayed</u> to the Lord his God." Jonah 2:1
"The disciples privately asked Jesus, 'Why couldn't we drive that bad spirit out?' Jesus answered, 'This kind can only be forced out BY PRAYER." Mark 9:28-29
