1. WHY SHOULD I FORGIVE?

2. BECAUSE

"To worry yourself to death with <u>resentment</u> would be a <u>foolish</u>, <u>senseless</u> thing to do." Job 5:2 (GN)

"You are <u>only hurting yourself</u> with your anger!" Job 18:4 (GN)

"Some men stay <u>healthy</u> until the day they die... others have <u>no happiness at all</u>; they live and die with <u>bitter hearts</u>." Job 21:23-25 (GN)

3. BECAUSE

II. HOW SHOULD I FORGIVE?

1. RECOGNIZE _____

2. RELINQUISH

"... *Never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it.*" Rom. 12:19 (LB)

"Peter asked, `Lord, <u>how often</u> should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?' `No,' Jesus replied, `seventy times seven!'" Matt. 18:21-22 (NLT)

3. RESPOND

"... <u>do good</u> to those who hate you, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, and <u>pray for</u> those who mistreat you." Luke 6:27-28 (NIV)

4. REFOCUS

"But among you there must not even be a hint of sexual immorality..." Eph. 5:3 (NIV)

5. MAINTAIN
