1. MY THOUGHTS BUT I CAN

"Be careful what you think about because your thoughts run your life!" Proverbs 4:23 (NCV)

"...your life is shaped by your thoughts." (TEV)

2. ANY CHANGE I WANT IN MY LIFE

"Do not conform yourselves to the standards of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind." Romans 12:2 (TEV)

3. EVERY BEHAVIOR IS BASED

6. AN UNSEEN WAR IS GOING ON

In my mind I want to be God's servant, but instead I find myself still enslaved to sin." Romans 7:21-23 (LB)

7. TO WIN THE BATTLE IN & FOR MY MIND, I MUST HAVE

"While we live in the world, we don't fight the same way the world does. We fight with God's weapons, not worldly ones. <u>Our weapons have God's power</u> to demolish the <u>enemy's strong places</u>. We can knock down all the worldly arguments and prideful defenses that set themselves up (in our minds) against the knowledge of God. In this war, <u>we capture every rebel thought</u> and we make it give up, and obey Christ!" 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

"If your sinful nature controls your mind, there is death. But if the Holy Spirit <u>controls your mind</u>, there is <u>life and</u> <u>peace.</u>" Romans 8:6 (NLT)

So REMEMBER what it was like before you fell away, and <u>REPENT</u> -change your mind and attitude, and RETURN to doing the things you did with me at first!" Revelation 2:2, 4-5

DEFINITION: WHAT IS IT?

SIN IS DEFINITION: WHAT IS IT?

1. SIN IS

"Everything God does is good and fair; all his commands can be trusted." Psalm 111:7 (NCV)

"It is impossible for God to do anything evil; He cannot sin or do wrong." Job 34:10 (MSG/NLT)

2. SIN IS

Jesus: "As sin and evil increase in the world, <u>people's love will grow cold</u>." Matthew 24:12 (NCV)

3. SIN IS ALWAYS

"Wherever there is...selfishness, you find disorder and every kind of evil sin." James 3:16 (NCV)

4. SIN IS ALWAYS

WHAT'S THE PROBLEM WITH SIN?

1. I WAS BORN WITH

"...I feel I am a slave to my sinful desires. Sin masters me. I don't even under-stand the things I do. I want to do what is right, but I don't do it! Instead I do the wrong things that I don't want to do! ...I can't help myself because of my sinful nature inside me... It's a law at work in me that is at war with my mind!" Romans 7:14-15, 17, 23 (NCV)

2. SIN BREAKS

"Your sins are the roadblock between you and your God. That's why he doesn't answer your prayers or let you see his face." Isaiah 59:2 (CEV)

3. EVERYTIME I SIN,

"Our evil desires make us sin, and when sin is finished with us, it leaves us dead." James 1:15 (CEV)

4. MY SIN MAY BE A SECRET BUT

"You may be sure that your sin will find you out." Numbers 32:23 (NIV)

5. SIN

"Don't <u>deceive yourself</u>: You can't make a fool out of God! <u>Whatever you plant</u> is <u>what you'll harvest</u>. If you plant in the soil of your sinful nature, you'll harvest destruction. But if you plant in the soil of your spiritual nature, you'll harvest everlasting life!" Galatians 6:7-8 (GW)

6.

"A fool's fun is in being bad." Proverbs 10:2 (LB) "Doing wrong is like a joke to a fool." (ESV)

"Because of your stubbornness in <u>refusing to repent and turn from your sin</u> you are storing up <u>terrible punishment</u> for yourself. For there is going to come a <u>day of judgment</u> when God will judge all people according to what they have done. He will give eternal life to those who <u>seek God</u>...but for those who are <u>self-seeking</u> and <u>reject the truth</u> and <u>practice sin</u>, they will face God's anger." Romans 2:5-8 (NIV/NLT)

HOW DO I BREAK FREE?

1. UNDERSTAND

"Although Jesus died on the cross in weakness, he now <u>lives by the mighty power of God.</u> We, too, are weak, but <u>we live in him</u> and <u>have God's power</u>." 2 Corinthians 13:4 (NLT)

2. LET GOD GIVE ME

"Those who have been born again into God's family will not continue in habitual sin, because God's life is in them now." 1 John 3:9 (NLT)

"If you have the Spirit of God living in you, you are controlled by your new nature!" Romans 8:9 (LB)

3. CHANGE THE WAY

"Jesus died to defeat sin once for all. Now he lives in and for God. In the same way, you should <u>think of yourselves</u> as dead to sin but alive to the power of God in Christ Jesus." Romans 6:10-11

"Do not let sin control the way you live anymore or do what your sinful nature wants to do. Don't let any part of your body become a tool of evil used for sinning. Instead, give yourselves completely to God since you have been given new life. Offer your body a tool for doing good for the glory of God." Romans 6:12-13 (NLT)

PAUL'S 7 SECRETS OF DEFEATING DISCOURAGEMENT 2 CORINTHIANS 4:1-18

1. "God <u>IN HIS MERCY</u> has given us this ministry and work to do. That's why we do not become discouraged and never give up!" 2 Corinthians 4:1

2.

"We don't try to trick anyone, and we don't twist the word of God. Instead we teach the truth plainly, showing everyone WHO WE REALLY ARE. Then they can know in their hearts what kind of people we are in God's sight." 2 Corinthians 4:2 (NLT/NCV)

3.

"Our message is NOT about ourselves. It is about Jesus Christ as the Lord. We are merely your servants for Jesus' sake." 2 Corinthians 4:5 (GW)

4.

4. "We are <u>like clay jars</u> in which God's treasure is stored. The real power comes from God and not from us." 2 Corinthians 4:7 (CEV)

5 WAYS TO USE YOUR PAIN FOR GOOD IN YOUR LIFE

1. USE PAIN

"We were crushed and overwhelmed ... and saw how powerless we were to help ourselves; but that was good, for then we put everything into the hands of God, who alone could save us...and he did help us!"

2 Corinthians 1:8-10 (LB)

"I am glad...not because it (your troubles) hurt you but because the pain turned you to God." 2 Corinthians 7:9 (LB)

3. USE PAIN (Discipleship) "Sometimes it takes a painful experience to make us change our ways." Proverbs 20:30 (TEV)

"So even though Jesus was God's Son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered." Hebrews 5:8 (NLT)

"Suffering made Jesus perfect, and now he can save forever all who obey him." Hebrews 5:9 (CEV)

"Now, isn't it wonderful all the ways in which this distress has goaded you closer to God? You're more alive, more concerned, more sensitive, more reverent, more human, more passionate, more responsible. Looked at from any angle, you've come out of this with purity of heart." 2 Corinthians 7:11 (MSG)

Paul's Testimony of Pain: 2 Corinthians 11:23-28 and 2 Corinthians 4:8-10

"FOR THIS REASON we never become discouraged. Even though our physical being is gradually decaying, yet our spiritual being is renewed day after day. And these temporary troubles we suffer will bring us a tremendous and eternal glory, much greater than the trouble. For we fix our attention, not on things that are seen, but on things that



are unseen. What can be seen lasts only for a time, but what cannot be seen lasts forever." 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (TEV)

4. USE PAIN

to give them the same comfort God has given us. You can be sure that the more we suffer for Christ, the more God will shower us with his comfort through Christ. So when we are weighed down with troubles, it is for your benefit and salvation! For when God comforts us, it is so that we, in turn, can be an encouragement to you.
