And when you judge God's Law you aren't keeping it yourself! Instead, you set yourself up as the Judge! Remember, God is the only true Lawgiver and Judge! He alone has the authority to save or to destroy. So then, who are you? And what gives you the right to pass judgment on others?" James 4:11-12

WHY ARE WE SO QUICK TO JUDGE OTHERS?

1. GUILT: WE WANT TO

"When you, a mere human, pass judgment on others, do you think that by pointing your finger at others <u>you will distract God</u> from seeing all your misdoings and keep him from judging you?"

Romans 2:3 (MSG/NIV)

2. PRIDE: WE WANT TO

Job: "You are trying to <u>make yourselves look better than me</u> by using my disgrace as an argument against me." Job 19:5 (GW)

WHY SHOULD I NOT JUDGE OTHERS?

1. JUDGING OTHERS IS

"The Royal Law found in the Scripture is 'Love your neighbor as you love yourself!' If you obey this law, you do the right thing." James 2:8

"Anytime you speak against fellow believers, or you judge or badmouth them, you judge and condemn God's Law!" James 4:11

2. JUDGING OTHERS IS

"Remember, God is the <u>only true Lawgiver and Judge!</u> He alone has the authority to save or to destroy. So then, who are you? And <u>what gives you the right</u> to pass judgment on others?" James 4:12

"Who are you to judge <u>someone else's servant?</u> To his own Master he stands or falls. And he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand." Romans 14:4 (NIV)

3. JUDGING OTHERS IS

"God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world guilty, but to save the world through him!" John 3:17 (NCV)

HOW CAN I LEARN TO BE LESS JUDGMENTAL?

1. REMEMBER

"We should never dare to classify or compare ourselves like those who rate themselves so highly. How foolish they are! They make up their own standards to measure themselves by, and then judge themselves by their own standards!" 2 Corinthians 10:12

2. REMEMBER

"It is shameful and stupid to decide before knowing the facts!"

Proverbs 18:13

Jesus: "Stop judging by appearances." John 7:24 (NIV)

3. REMEMBER

"No one can really know what anyone else is thinking or what he is really like except that person himself." 1 Corinthians 2:11 (LB)

"Therefore <u>judge no one</u> before the appointed time; wait till the Lord returns. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and <u>he will expose the motives of men's hearts</u>. At that time each will receive the right praise from God." 1 Corinthians 4:5 (NIV)

4. REMEMBER

Jesus: "Why are you so concerned about a speck of sawdust in someone else's eye when you have a huge log in your own eye? How dare you say, 'Let me get that speck out of your eye!'... Instead judge yourself and first remove the log in your own eye so you can see clearly to help others." Matthew 7:3-5

"If we <u>judged ourselves</u> in the right way, <u>God would not judge us."</u>

1 Corinthians 11:31 (NCV)

5. REMEMBER

Nicodemus: "According to God's Law we cannot judge people before listening to them and hearing what they've done." John 7:51

6. REMEMBER

Jesus: "Do not judge others, or YOU too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged! And with the same measure you use, YOU will be measured!" Matthew 7:1-2

"You have no right to criticize your brother or look down on him. Remember, each of us will <u>stand personally before the Judgment Seat of God...</u> Yes, each of us will have to <u>give an account</u> of himself to God. <u>So then</u>, don't criticize each other anymore!"

Definition: Quarrel – "A heated argument, typically about a trivial issue, between people who are usually on good terms."

But you don't have, because you don't ask God for it. And if you ask, you don't receive it because you ask with the wrong motivation - you only want what gives you pleasure. You cheat on God when you have an affair with what the world values. To love what the world loves is to hate God and to be the enemy of God! This is what the Scripture means when it says that God's Spirit who lives inside us is intensely jealous. He wants our exclusive love. That's why he gives us so much grace! As Scripture says, 'God opposes the prideful but gives his grace to the humble.' So, give yourselves completely to God! Then resist the devil, and he'll flee from you. If you draw close to God, he will draw close to you. Wash your hands of your sins, and purify your heart of your double-minded living. Be sad and sorry and grieve over your actions. Stop laughing at your sin and get serious about it. If you humble yourself before the Lord, he will lift you up!" James 4:1-10

WHAT CAUSES QUARRELS?

"What causes quarrels and arguments with each other? They come from the conflicting selfish desires that are always fighting inside you." James 4:1

"Our sinful desires <u>want what is opposite</u> of God's Spirit, and God's Spirit wants what is contrary to our sinful desires. So <u>the two are constantly fighting each</u> other, so you cannot just do whatever you please." Galatians 5:17

WHAT WILL HELP ME QUARREL LESS?

1. REALIZE

"Quarreling, harsh words, and dislike of others should have no place in your lives!" Ephesians 4:31b (LB)

Quarreling is a Mark of Immaturity:

"You are still only baby Christians, controlled by your own desires, not God's. When you are jealous and divide into quarreling groups, doesn't that prove you

are still babies, wanting your own way? In fact, you are acting like people who don't belong to the Lord at all!" 1 Corinthians 3:3 (LB)

"The fool who provokes his family to anger and resentment will finally have nothing worthwhile left." Proverbs 11:29 (LB)

2. DECIDE I WANT TO

"Wash your hands of your sins, and purify your heart of your double-minded living. Be sad and sorry and grieve over your actions. Stop laughing at your sin and get serious about it." James 4:8b-9

3. STOP ______ TO FULFILL NEEDS IN MY LIFE THAT ONLY GOD CAN FULFILL

"You don't have, BECAUSE you <u>don't ask God for it</u>. And if you ask, you don't receive it because <u>you ask with the wrong motivation</u>..." James 4:2b-3

4. CHOOSE

LIVING IN A CULTURE OF ANGER & BITTERNESS

"Everyone has turned from God and is going the wrong direction. Nobody is living right. People tell lies about others that stink like an open grave. They verbally attack each other with poisonous words like the venom of a deadly snake. Their speech is filled with vicious curses and bitter resentment, and they are quick to react violently with anyone who disagrees. So, wherever they go, they leave division and misery because they've never learned how to live in peace." Romans 3:12-17

James to believers: "(In worship), we praise our Lord and Father but then (in the world) we curse the people that God himself created in his image! Out of the same mouth comes blessing and bitterness! Brothers and sisters, this is not right! There is no way that SWEET water and BITTER water can flow out of the same spring!" James 3:9-10

WHY SHOULD I NEVER HOLD ON TO A HURT?

(THE COST OF BITTERNESS)

1. ANYTIME I HARBOR A HURT,
"If you are angry, you <u>cannot</u> do ANY of the good things that God wants done!" James 1:20 (CEV)

"Human anger does not achieve God's righteous purpose." James 1:20 (TEV)

2. ANYTIME I RETAIN RESENTMENT, __

"Some men stay happy until the day they die... others have no happiness at all; because they live and die with bitter hearts." Job 21:23-25 (TEV)

3. ANYTIME I BREATHE BITTERNESS,

"A stone is heavy and sand is weighty, but the resentment caused by a fool is heavier than both." Proverbs 27:3 (NLT)

"You are only hurting yourself with your anger." Job 18:4 (TEV)

4. ANYTIME I INTERNALIZE ANGER, _

do." Job 5:2 (TEV)

"All they get are days full of sadness and sorrow, and they end up sick, defeated, and angry." Ecclesiastes 5:17 (NCV)

5. ANYTIME I HOLD A GRUDGE,

"Look after each other so that you keep living in God's grace, being gracious to each other. See that no root of bitterness grows up among you, because if you become bitter about anything, you'll miss God's grace, and that will cause much trouble. A bitter person will poison and ruin everyone else."

Hebrews 12:15

6. ANYTIME I WON'T LET IT GO,

7. ANYTIME I WON'T FORGIVE,
