THREE Wise Choices That Will Bless the Rest of Your Life Rick Warren December 14-15, 2019

1st WISE WOMAN OF CHRISTMAS:

"When Herod was king of Judah there was a priest named Zechariah...and his wife was named Elizabeth. Both Zechariah and Elizabeth were righteous and godly people. <u>Their lives pleased God because they always did everything</u> <u>God commanded and they lived with a clear conscience before God.</u> BUT THEY HAD NO CHILDREN, because Elizabeth had been unable to conceive and now, they were both too old." Luke 1:5-7

Elizabeth's Story: The Miraculous Birth of John the Baptist Luke 1:5-25, 56-66

- "Your persistent prayers have been heard." vs. 13
- "Every word I've told you will happen <u>at just the right time.</u>" vs. 20

"Some time later, Elizabeth became pregnant and for five months she never left her house. <u>But she kept praising God saying 'The Lord did this for me</u>! He has shown his blessing and taken away my shame and pain." Luke 1:24-25

ELIZABETH WAS BLESSED BECAUSE SHE CHOSE:

- "I am the Lord's servant and I accept his plans for me. Let it happen according to your word." vs. 38
- Elizabeth to Mary: "God has <u>blessed you</u> because <u>you believed that</u> <u>God would keep his word</u>." vs. 45

MARY WAS BLESSED BECAUSE SHE CHOSE:

3rd WISE WOMAN OF CHRISTMAS:

"After the birth of Jesus Joseph and Mary took the baby to the Temple in Jerusalem <u>to dedicate him to God</u>, because the law that God gave Moses said 'Every first born boy is to be dedicated back to God."" Luke 2:22-23

"That day there was also a woman named Anna worshipping in the Temple courts. Anna was a prophetess and she was very old. She'd been a widow most of her life because <u>her husband had died after being married only 7</u> <u>years</u>. Anna was now 84 years old and since she had no family, she never left the Temple courtyards. <u>She stayed there day and night, worshiping God with</u> <u>prayers and fasting</u>. Just as Simeon was dedicating the baby to God, Anna walked by and she paused to listen. Then Anna joined in praying for the baby and she thanked God for sending a Savior. <u>FROM THEN ON ANNA TALKED</u> <u>ABOUT JESUS TO EVERYONE</u> who was <u>looking for redemption and freedom</u> in Jerusalem." Luke 2:36-38

ANNA WAS BLESSED BECAUSE SHE CHOSE:

2nd WISE WOMAN OF CHRISTMAS:

"In the 6th month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a young virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph. The girl's name was Mary. The angel said, 'Greetings! God has chosen you for a SPECIAL BLESSING and he is with you!' <u>Mary was frightened and confused</u> and tried to figure out what this greeting might mean. So the angel said to her, '<u>Don't be frightened Mary</u>, for God has <u>decided to</u> <u>bless you</u> in a wonderful way!'" Luke 1:26-29

> Mary's Story: The Miraculous Virgin Birth of Jesus Luke 1:26-56

- "Mary was frightened and confused." vs. 29
- "Nothing is impossible with God." vs. 37

2. THE FIRST TIME: JESUS' ARRIVAL

NEXT TIME:

"For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with <u>LOUD COMMAND</u>, and with the <u>SHOUT of the archangel</u>, and with the <u>GREAT SOUND of the trumpet</u> of God!" 1 Thessalonians 4:16

3. THE FIRST TIME:

NEXT TIME: JESUS WILL

JESUS: "For just as lightning flashes light up <u>the ENTIRE SKY</u> and <u>EVERYONE</u> can see it, so will be the return of the Son of God!"

Matthew 24:27

JESUS: "When I come back in <u>ALL my glory</u>, <u>ALL the holy angels</u> will be with me!" Matthew 25:31

4. THE FIRST TIME: _____

NEXT TIME:

"As surely as I am the living God, <u>EVERYONE</u> will <u>kneel before me</u>, and <u>EVERYONE</u> will <u>confess that I am God!</u>" Romans 14:11

5. THE FIRST TIME: JESUS CAME ____

"For <u>God so loved the world</u> that he gave his only Son, so that everyone <u>who</u> <u>believes in him</u> will not perish but have eternal life! God did NOT send his Son into the world to condemn it, <u>but to save it</u>!" John 3:16-17 (NLT)

NEXT TIME: HE'S COMING

"God has set a day when the entire human race will be judged <u>WITH</u> <u>JUSTICE</u> and everything set right. And God has <u>already appointed the</u> <u>Judge,</u> confirming him before everyone by raising him from the dead." Acts 17:31 (MSG)

"God will <u>reward or punish</u> every person for what that person has done. For those who have lived for God's glory and honor... <u>God will reward</u> them with life forever. But for those who continue to live for themselves and reject the truth, and follow evil instead of obeying God...they will receive <u>God's anger and punishment</u>." Romans 2:6-8

6. THE FIRST TIME: JESUS CAME

"God's unchanging plan has always been to <u>adopt us into his OWN FAMILY</u> by <u>sending Jesus Christ to die for us</u>." Ephesians 1:5 (LB)

NEXT TIME: HE'S COMING

"He will send his angels all around the earth, and they will <u>gather his</u> chosen people from every part of the world." Matthew 24:31 (NCV)

"God's family is the Church of the living God." 1 Timothy 3:15 (NCV)

7. THE FIRST TIME: HE CAME

"Though he was God...he made himself nothing, taking on the humble position of a servant and becoming a human! And while living as a man he humbled himself even further by obediently dying on a cross!" Philippians 2:6-8 (NLT)

NEXT TIME:

"Because he humbled himself, God has <u>exalted Jesus to the highest</u> <u>place</u> and given him the name that is above every other name so that at the name of Jesus <u>every knee will bow</u>, in heaven and on earth and every <u>tongue will confess</u> that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God!" Philippians 2:9-11 (NLT)
