WHAT DID JESUS COMPLETE ON THE CROSS?

"Jesus said, 'This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.' 1. I NEED TO REACH OUT _____

2. I NEED TO REACH OUT _____

3 THINGS TO PRAY

- Affirm God’s power: *I know you can do anything!*
- Express your desire: *I don’t want this pain!*
- Offer your trust: *I want your will, not mine*
