READ YOUR BIBLE FIRST

During the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, was <u>studying the Scriptures</u>. <u>I learned from the Word</u> of the Lord, as recorded by Jeremiah the prophet, that Jerusalem must lie desolate for seventy years."
