Pt 1. HOW TO PRAY IN A CRISIS (5 Steps from Daniel 9:1-23)

"If my people, who are called by my name, will HUMBLE themselves and PRAY and SEEK my face and TURN from their wrong ways, then I will HEAR from heaven and will FORGIVE their sin and HEAL their land!" 2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)

Pt. 2. PRAYING & FASTING FOR A PERSONAL BREAKTHROUGH (4 Keys)

"Don't <u>worry about anything</u>; instead, <u>pray about everything</u>. Tell God whatever you need <u>but always ask for it with THANKSGIVING</u>, asking him <u>with a thankful heart</u> for all he's done. If you do this, you'll experience <u>God's peace</u> which is far more powerful than we can understand. <u>His peace will keep your thoughts</u> and <u>emotions</u> at rest <u>as you trust in Christ Jesus</u>. Then <u>fix your thoughts</u> on things that are true and honorable and right. <u>Think about things</u> that are pure and lovely and admirable, and <u>fill your mind</u> with thoughts that are excellent and worthy of praise."
