And if the light you think you have is really darkness, it's the worst kind of darkness you can have!" Matthew 6:22-23

EXAMPLE: SEEING THE FUTURE WITH FAITH OR FEAR

"Moses gave the men these instructions as he sent them out to explore the new land: 'Go northward through the Negev into the hill country and <u>SEE what the land is like</u> and <u>FIND OUT</u> whether the people living there are strong or weak, few or many. What kind of land do they live in? Is it good or bad? Do their towns have walls or are they unprotected? How is the soil? Is it fertile or poor? Are there many trees? <u>Enter the</u> <u>land boldly</u>, and bring back samples of the crops <u>YOU SEE</u>." Numbers 13:17-20 (NLT)

"So they <u>SPIED OUT</u> the land all the way from the wilderness . . . up to Hebron. There <u>THEY SAW</u> the Ahmanites, the Sheshites, and the Talmites, all families descended from Anak. When they came to Eshcol, they cut down a cluster of grapes so large that it took two of them to carry it back on a pole! They also took samples of pomegranates and figs." Numbers 13:21-23 (TLB)

"After <u>SEEING the land for</u> forty days, the men returned to Moses and Aaron, and the people of Israel waiting at Kadesh in the wilderness of Paran. They reported to the whole community <u>WHAT THEY HAD SEEN</u> and showed them the fruit they had taken from the land." Numbers 13:25-26 (NLT)

LOOKING AT THE FUTURE WITH FEAR CAUSES PROBLEMS

1. I OVEREMPHASIZE _

"This was their report to Moses: 'We <u>arrived</u> in the land you sent us <u>TO SEE</u>, and it <u>is indeed a magnificent country</u>—a land "flowing with milk and honey!" Here is some of its fruit as proof. <u>BUT</u> the people living there are powerful, and their cities and towns are fortified and very large. We <u>ALSO SAW</u> the Anakim, descendants of Anak, who are living there!" Numbers 13:27-28 (TLB)

2. I PAY TOO MUCH ATTENTION TO

"The Amalekites live in the Negev; the Hittites, Jebusites and Amorites live in the Hill Country; and the Canaanites live near the Sea and along the Jordan River!" Numbers 13:29 (NLT)

3. I UNDERESTIMATE

"But the men who had gone up with Caleb said, 'WE CAN'T attack those people; they are stronger than we are." Numbers 13:31 (NIV)

Job: "What I have always feared has happened to me. What I have dreaded has come to be." Job 3:25 (NLT)

"They said, 'The land we explored DEVOURS those living in it! ALL the people we saw there are of great size! We SAW GIANTS there! We seemed like grasshoppers <u>IN OUR OWN EYES</u>, and we <u>looked the same</u> to them!'"

Numbers 13:32-33 (NIV)

4. I

"They SPREAD A <u>BAD REPORT</u> about the land they had explored."

Numbers 13:32

"Don't say that everything people call a conspiracy is a conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear. Don't let it terrify you." Isaiah 8:12 (GW)

5. I_____

"Then all the people began weeping aloud, and <u>they cried all night</u>. And <u>they</u> <u>grumbled and complained</u> in a great chorus against their leaders, Moses and Aaron. <u>'We wish we'd died</u> in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!' they wailed." Numbers 14:1-2

THE ANTIDOTE:

"Then Caleb silenced the people before Moses and said, 'We should go <u>at once</u> and take possession of the land RIGHT NOW! <u>WE CAN certainly do this</u>!""

Numbers 13:30 (NLT)

"Then Joshua said: 'We saw the land ourselves, and it's <u>very good</u>. <u>IF WE OBEY</u> the Lord, he will <u>surely give us</u> that land rich with milk and honey. <u>So don't rebel</u>. We have <u>no reason to be afraid</u> of the people who live there. <u>The Lord is on our side</u>, and they won't stand a chance against us!" Numbers 14:6-9 (CEV)
