WHAT'S MY CUP?

"On the last day of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds: 'If you are thirsty, come to me and drink! Everyone who really believes in me will have rivers of living water flowing out of their lives." John 7:37-38 (NLT)

WHAT IS AN OVERFLOWING LIFE?

"I am the holy God, who rescues you. <u>For your own good</u>, I teach you, and I lead you along the right path. How I wish that you had <u>obeyed my commands</u>! Then your success and good fortune would have OVERFLOWED like a flooding river!" Isaiah 48:17-18 (CEV)

Jesus: "I've come that you may have real life, and <u>enjoy it in abundance</u>—to the fullest, until it <u>overflows</u>!" John 10:10 (AMP)

HOW CAN I EXPERIENCE AN OVERFLOWING LIFE?

1.

Jesus: "I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay connected to me . . . you'll produce a lot of fruit. But you <u>can't do anything</u> without me!"

John 15:5

Jesus: "If you stay <u>connected to me</u> and my <u>words remain in you</u>, you may ask <u>any request</u> you like, and it <u>will be granted</u>! My true disciples produce much fruit. This brings glory to my Father . . . So, stay connected to my love. You stay connected to my love when you obey me . . . I've told you this so that you'll be filled with my joy. Yes, <u>your cup of joy will OVERFLOW</u>!" John 15:7-11 (NLT/TLB)
