But after his soul suffers many things, he will enjoy life and joy again! But my Suffering Servant will make many people right with God and he will bear all their sins . . . He willingly gave his life and was treated like a criminal but he took the place of every one who has sinned and he interceded for their forgiveness." Isaiah 53:5-12

"He was despised and rejected by others. He was a <u>man of sorrows</u>, who endured much pain and suffering; He <u>experienced deep grief</u> but we ignored him and looked the other way. He was hated and we did not care. Yet it was <u>OUR weaknesses</u> that he was carrying and it was <u>OUR sorrows</u> that weighed him down." Isaiah 53:3-4

"He <u>heals</u> the brokenhearted and <u>binds up</u> their wounds." Psalm 147:3 (NIV)

"To all who mourn . . . he will give: beauty for ashes; joy instead of mourning; praise instead of heaviness." Isaiah 61:3 (TLB)
