WHAT KIND OF VALLEYS TO EXPECT Significant Valleys in the Bible

• THE VALLEY OF SIDDIM (GENESIS 14:1-11)

"This valley was full of sticky tar pits, and when (they) tried to run away from the battle, they slipped and fell in the pits." Genesis 14:10

• THE VALLEY OF ESHCOL (NUMBERS 13:23-33)

"In our own eyes we felt as small as grasshoppers next to them."

Numbers 13:33

• THE VALLEY OF ELAH (1 SAMUEL 17:1-58)

"The Philistines occupied one hill and the Israelites another, with the valley of Elah between them." 1 Samuel 17:3

• THE VALLEY OF BACA (PSALM 84:5-7)

"Blessed are those whose strength comes from the Lord . . . As they pass through the Valley of Baca (WEEPING) they make it a place of springs." Psalm 84:5-6

WHAT TO REMEMBER IN A VALLEY

1. REMEMBER

"Even when I walk through the Valley of the Shadow of Death. (Salmawet) I will fear no evil, for you are with me!" Psalm 23:4

"When you go through deep waters and great trouble, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown! When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up—the flames will not consume you!"
