#### How to Discover God's Dream for You

### 1. DEDICATE

"Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to his service . . . Do not conform to the standards of this world, but let God transform you . . . Then you will be able to know the will of God—what is good . . . pleasing . . . and perfect." Romans 12:1-2 (GNT)

"Let us strip off anything that slows us down or holds us back . . . and run with patience the particular race that God has set before us." Hebrews 12:1 (TLB)

# 2. RESERVE

(To Job) "Pause a moment and listen! Consider the wonderful things God does." Job 37:14 (GNT)

## What to Do While Waiting

١.	DON'T
	"They would not enter the land. They said 'We <u>are afraid</u> The people there are stronger and taller than we are" Deuteronomy 1:26, 28 (GNT)
	Instead:
	"Fear not, for I am with you. Do not be dismayed. I am your God, I will strengthen you and I will help you and uphold you" Isaiah 41:10 (TLB)
<u>?</u> .	DON'T "On the way the people lost their patience and spoke against God and Moses. They complained" Numbers 21:4-5 (GNT)
	"Impatience will get you into trouble." Proverbs 19:2 (GNT)
	Instead:
	" $\underline{Rest}$ in the Lord; wait patiently for Him to act $\underline{Don't\ fret}$ and worry—it only leads to harm." Psalm 37:7-8 (TLB)
	"God has set the <u>right time</u> for everything." Ecclesiastes 3:11 (GNT)
3.	<b>DON'T</b> "All the Israelites grumbled against Moses 'If only we had died in Egypt! We should choose a leader and go back to Egypt." Numbers 14:2-4
	Instead:

"Let us never grow tired of doing what's right, for if we <u>do not faint</u>, we'll reap a harvest at the right time." Galatians 6-9

"You need to pray continually and not lose heart." Luke 18:1 (PHILLIPS)

#### 4. DON'T

"They forgot the many times God showed them his love, and they rebelled . . . at the Red Sea. But He saved them as He promised . . . But they quickly forgot again! They wouldn't wait for God to act" Psalm 106:7-8 (GNT), 13 (TLB)

"I will bless the Lord and <u>not forget</u> the great things He does for me."

"The Lord is <u>not being slow to carry out his promises</u> . . . but He is <u>being patient</u> with you" 2 Peter 3:3-8 (PHILLIPS)

"These things won't happen right away. Slowly, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled. If it seems slow, do not despair, for these things will <u>surely</u> come to pass. <u>Just be patient!</u> They will not be overdue a single day!" Habakkuk 2:3 (TLB)

# How to Deal with Difficulty Acts 27

1.	DETERMINE
	Ask:
	"I tried to think this problem through but it was too difficult for me until I went into your Temple." Psalm 73:16-17 (GNT)
	Common Mistakes
	We listen to "they followed the advice of the pilot" (vs. 11)
	We follow "the majority decided that we should sail" (vs 12) "The majority decided that we should sail" (vs 12)
	• We rely on "When a gentle south wind began to blow, they thought they had obtained what they wanted" (vs 13)
2.	DETERMINE
	Ask:
	"These little troubles, which are temporary, are winning for us a permanent,

glorious and <u>solid reward</u> all out of proportion to our pain." 2 Corinthians 4:17 "We can rejoice when we run into problems and trials for <u>we know</u>... they help us <u>learn</u> to be patient. And patience develops <u>strength of character</u> in us and helps us trust God more each time" Romans 5:3-4 (TLB)

3. DETERMINE
Ask:
Wrong Responses
"To Drift" "so we gave way to it and were driven along." (vs 15)
"To Discard: "they began to throw the cargo overboard" (vs 18)
"To Despair" "we finally gave up all hope of being saved." (vs 20)
THE RIGHT RESPONSE
CONFESS  "A man who refuses to admit his mistakes can never be successful. But if he confesses and forsakes them, he gets another chance."  Proved a 20:40 (TLR)
Proverbs 28:13 (TLB)
• CONFRONT
• CLAIM
(vs 22-25)

# FROM DEADEND TO DELIVERANCE

Created to Dream: The 6 Phases God Uses to Grow Your Faith Rick Warren

## Abraham's Example of Faith

Phase 1: A DREAM (Age 75) Genesis 12:1-3 (God) "I will make you into a great nation"

Phase 2: A DECISION Genesis 12:4
"So Abraham left as the Lord had told him to"

Phase 3: DELAY (Age 86) Genesis 16:1 "But Sarah still had not borne any children"

Phase 4: DIFFICULTY (Age 99) Genesis 17:18 "How can a son be born to a man my age?"

Phase 5: DEADEND Genesis 21:1-6, 22:1-12 "Take your only son, whom you love, and sacrifice him"

Phase 6: DELIVERANCE! Genesis 22:12-14 (God) "Don't hurt the boy... I've provided a lamb"

## What to Do When You Reach "Deadend" Romans 4:17-20

### 1. REMEMBER

"Abraham believed in God who gives life to the dead and who creates something out of nothing." vs 17 (TLB)

"What is impossible with men is possible with God." Luke 18:27

#### 2. RELY ON

"When hope was dead within him, Abraham went on hoping in faith . . . He <u>relied</u> on the word of God" vs 18 (PHILLIPS)

"While God was testing him, Abraham <u>still trusted in God and his promises</u>, so he offered his son Isaac" Hebrews 11:17 (TLB)

"Though it <u>seemed</u> Abraham's hope could not be fulfilled . . . he <u>did</u> become the father of many nations, exactly as God had promised." vs 18 (PHILLIPS)

#### 3. FACE THE FACTS

"Without weakening in his faith, he <u>faced the fact</u> that his body was as good as dead . . . and Sarah's womb was also dead. Yet <u>he didn't waver with unbelief</u>" vs 19-20

"We <u>fix our eyes</u> . . . on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal." 2 Corinthians 4:8

#### 4. EXPECT

"But Abraham never doubted . . . he <u>praised God</u> for this blessing <u>even before it happened</u>. He was completely sure that God was able to do anything He promised." vs 20-21 (TLB)

(Paul) "But this happened so we might not rely on ourselves but on God who raises the dead! He <u>has delivered</u> us... He <u>will deliver</u> us... (and) we have set our hope that He will continue to deliver us" 2 Corinthians 1:9-10

#### Three Kinds of Deliverance

(1) Circumstantial (2) Personal) (3) Ultimate (Heaven)
