He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat." Luke 5:1-3 (NIV)

"When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch.' Simon answered, 'Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets.""

"Simon answered, 'Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." Luke 5:5 (NIV)

WHEN: "Now launch out"
WHAT: "Let down your nets"
WHERE: "into deep water"

The Faith Factor: You must trust him to do what he says he'll do.

"When they had done so, they <u>caught such a large number</u> of fish that their nets began to break. So they <u>signaled their partners</u> in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and <u>filled both boats</u> so full that they began to sink!" Luke 5:6-7 (NIV)

PETER'S REACTION

"When Simon Peter saw this, <u>he fell at Jesus' knees</u> and said, 'Go away from me, Lord; <u>I am a sinful man!</u>' For he and all his companions were <u>astonished</u> at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners." Luke 5:8-9 (NIV)
