Critics: "It's true that some are preaching out of jealousy and rivalry." Philippians 1:15 (NLT)

Companions (who care): "Others preach about Christ with pure motives. They preach because they love me, for they know I have been appointed to defend the Good News." Philippians 1:15-16 (NLT)

Competitors: "Others are insincere. They tell the message about Christ out of selfish ambition." Philippians 1:17 (NLT)

Challengers: "Others . . . stir up trouble for me while I'm in prison." Philippians 1:17

Paul's Attitude: "But it doesn't matter! The important thing is that in every way, whether for right or wrong reasons, they are preaching about Christ. So I am happy, and I will continue to be happy!" Philippians 1:18 (NCV)

"Fearlessly, no matter what your enemies may do. They will see this as a sign of their downfall, but for you it will be a clear sign from God that he is with you, and that he has given you eternal life with him." Philippians 1:28 (TLB)
