10 CHARACTERISTICS OF THINKING LIKE JESUS

1. I KNOW

Jesus: "I am the Bread of Life." John 6:35, "The light of the world." John 8:12, "The good shepherd." John 10:11, "The resurrection and the life." John 11:25, "The way, the truth and the life." John 14:6, "The True Vine." John 15, "The Son of God." Mark 14:62

2. I KNOW

"I know where I came from and where I am going." John 8:14 (NIV)

Jesus at 12: "I must be about my Father's business" Luke 2:49 (KJV)

"I <u>must</u> preach the good news of the kingdom of God . . . for <u>I was sent for this purpose</u>." Luke 4:43 (RSV)

"My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life." John 10:10 (NLT)

3. I'M ALWAYS AWARE

"I am not alone because the Father is always with me." John 16:32 (NLT)

"He slipped quietly away to deserted places for prayer." Luke 5:15-16 (NCV)

4. I LET GOD HELP ME

"I have not spoken on my own. Instead, the Father who sent me told me what I should say and how I should say it." John 12:49 (GW)

5. I DON'T WORRY ABOUT

"I try to please the One who sent me." John 5:30 (NCV)

"No one can serve two masters." Luke 16:13 (NIV)

6. I DEPEND ON

"I tell you, the Son can <u>do nothing by himself</u>; he can do only what he sees his Father doing." John 5:19 (NIV)

7. I FORGIVE

"Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." Luke 23:34 (NIV)

"Love your enemies, <u>bless</u> them that curse you, <u>do good</u> to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you."

Matthew 5:44 (KJV)

8. I AM WILLING

"I am the good shepherd . . . So I sacrifice my life for the sheep."

John 10:14-15 (NLT)

"Came here not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Mark 10:45 (ESV)

"This is how we know what love is: Christ gave his life for us. We too, then, ought to give our lives for others!" 1 John 3:16 (GNT)

9. I WANT TO DO

"I came . . . to do what God wants me to do, not what I want to do."

John 6:38 (NCV)

"The world must know that I love the Father, so I do exactly what the Father told me to do." John 14:31 (NCV)
