Romans 7:15-25 (TLB)

THE COST OF THE BATTLE

1.

"I <u>don't understand myself at all</u>, for I really want to do what is right, but I can't. I do what I don't want to—what I hate." vs. 15

2.

"I <u>know perfectly well</u> that what I am doing is wrong, and my <u>bad conscience</u> proves that I agree with these laws I am breaking." vs. 16

3.

"But I can't help myself because <u>I'm no longer doing it.</u> <u>It is sin inside me</u> that is <u>stronger than I am,</u> that makes me do these evil things." vs. 17

4.

"I know I am rotten through and through so far as my old sinful nature is concerned." vs. 18

5.

"No matter which way I turn <u>I can't make myself do right</u>. I want to but I can't. When I want to do good, I don't; and when I try not to do wrong, I do it anyway. Now if I am doing what I don't want to, it is plain where the trouble is: sin still has me in its evil grasp." vs. 18-20

6.

"It <u>seems to be a fact of life</u> that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong . . . <u>In my mind I want</u> to be God's willing servant, but instead I find myself still <u>enslaved to sin</u>." vs. 21, 23

"<u>I love to do God's will</u> so far as my <u>new nature is</u> concerned; but there is something else deep within me, in <u>my lower nature</u>, that is <u>at war</u> with <u>my mind</u> and wins the fight and makes me a slave to the sin that is <u>still</u> within me." vs. 21, 23

"So you see how it is: my <u>new life tells me to do right</u>, but the <u>old nature</u> that is still inside me loves to sin. Oh, what a terrible predicament I'm in!" vs. 24
