"I sank down, down into the deep sea." Jonah 2:3 (NCV)

"But as the ship was sailing along, suddenly the Lord flung a terrific wind." Jonah 1:4 (TLB)

4) IF I RUN FROM GOD,

"A forceful wind into the sea and there was such a mighty storm on the sea that the ship was about to shatter." Jonah 1:4 (TLV)

"Fearing for their lives, the desperate sailors shouted to their gods for help and threw the cargo overboard to lighten the ship. But all this time Jonah was sound asleep down in the hold." Jonah 1:5 (NLT)

"They asked him. 'What terrible thing have you done to bring all this trouble on us?" Jonah 1:8 (NIRV)

6. THE LONGER I RUN FROM GOD,

"And since the storm was getting worse all the time, they asked him, 'What should we do to you to stop this storm?" Jonah 1:11 (NLT)

"Jonah said, 'Throw me overboard, into the sea. Then the storm will stop. It's all my fault. I'm the cause of the storm. Get rid of me and you'll get rid of the storm." Jonah 1:12 (MSG)

7. IF I'M FIGHTING GOD'S PLAN, _____

"The sailors tried their best to row to the shore. But they could not do it. and the storm kept getting worse every minute." Jonah 1:13 (CEV)

8. WHEN I DO WHAT GOD WANTS, _

"So the men cried to the Lord, 'Lord, please don't let us die because of taking this man's life. Please don't think we are guilty of killing an innocent man. Lord, you have caused all this to happen. You wanted it this way.' Then the men picked up Jonah and threw him into the sea. So the sea became calm."

"The sailors were <u>awestruck</u> by the Lord's great power, and they offered him a sacrifice and vowed to serve him." John 1:16 (NLT)
