**1. MY LIFE MISSION** "The Lord spoke his word to Jonah, son of Amittai." Jonah 1:1 (GW)

#### 2. MY LIFE MISSION

MY LIFE MISSION "Get up and go to the great city of Nineveh." Jonah 1:2 (NLT)

"Preach to them. They're in a bad way and I can't ignore it any longer." Jonah 1:2 (MSG)

#### 5. RUNNING FROM MY MISSION CAUSES BAD CONSEQUENCES

#### 1) IF I RUN FROM GOD

"He went down to Joppa, where he found a ship headed for the port. After paying the fare, he went aboard and sailed for Tarshish to flee from the Lord." Jonah 1:3 (NIV)

"Jonah had gone down into the lowest part of the ship, to lay down and fell fast asleep." Jonah 1:5 (TLV)

"I sank down, down into the deep sea." Jonah 2:3 (NCV)

"I was as far down as a body can go." Jonah 2:6 (MSG)

2) IF I RUN FROM GOD, \_\_\_\_\_\_ "He <u>paid the fare</u> and went down into it to go with them to Tarshish." Jonah 1:3 (CSB)

3) IF I RUN FROM GOD, "But as the ship was sailing along, suddenly the Lord flung a terrific wind." Jonah 1:4 (TLB)

4) IF I RUN FROM GOD, "A forceful wind into the sea and <u>there was such a mighty storm</u> on the sea that the ship was about to shatter." Jonah 1:4 (TLV)

"Fearing for their lives, the desperate sailors shouted to their gods for help and threw the cargo overboard to lighten the ship. But all this time Jonah was sound asleep down in the hold." Jonah 1:5 (NLT)

"They asked him. What terrible thing have you done to bring all this trouble on us?" Jonah 1:8 (NIRV)

### 6. THE LONGER I RUN FROM GOD,

"And since the storm was <u>getting worse</u> all the time, they asked him, 'What should we do to you to stop this storm?" Jonah 1:11 (NLT)

"Jonah said, 'Throw me overboard, into the sea. Then the storm will stop. It's all my fault. I'm the cause of the storm. Get rid of me and you'll get rid of the storm."" Jonah 1:12 (MSG)

7. IF I'M FIGHTING GOD'S PLAN, "The sailors <u>tried their best</u> to row to the shore. <u>But they could not do it</u>, and the storm kept getting worse every minute." Jonah 1:13 (CEV)

### 8. WHEN I DO WHAT GOD WANTS,

"So the men cried to the Lord, 'Lord, please don't let us die because of taking this man's life. Please don't think we are guilty of killing an innocent man. Lord, you have caused all this to happen. You wanted it this way.' Then the men picked up Jonah and threw him into the sea. So the sea became calm."

Jonah 1:14-15 (ICB)

**9. WHEN I DO WHAT GOD WANTS,** "The sailors were <u>awestruck</u> by the Lord's great power, and they offered him a sacrifice and vowed to serve him." John 1:16 (NLT)

. WHEN I ACCEPT MY MISSION, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ "Now the Lord had <u>arranged</u> for a great fish to <u>swallow</u> Jonah. And Jonah was inside the fish for three days and three nights." Jonah 1:17 (NLT)

### 7 STEPS FROM JONAH 2:1-10

"From inside the fish Jonah praved to the Lord his God." Jonah 2:1 (NIV)

"His disciples asked him privately, 'Why couldn't we drive it out?' He replied, 'This kind can come out only by prayer." Mark 9:28-29 (NIV)

"He said, '<u>I cried out</u> to the Lord <u>in my great trouble</u>, and he answered me." Jonah 2:2 (NLT)

#### A Warning: cautionary advice about a danger, trap, or problem

"For three years I <u>never stopped warning</u> each of you night and day <u>with tears</u>!" Acts 20:31 (NIV)

*"Jonah <u>warned</u> the people, 'Forty days from now, Nineveh will be destroyed!'"* Jonah 3:4 (NCV)

### We are to *humbly accept* warnings & *lovingly give* warnings

"The people of Nineveh believed God . . . <u>dressed in sackcloth</u> . . . the king of Nineveh, he got up from his throne, took off his robe, put on sackcloth, and sat in ashes. Then he made this announcement and sent it throughout the city: ' . . . <u>No one is to eat or drink anything.</u> Turn from your wicked ways and your acts of violence. Who knows? God may reconsider his plans and turn from his burning anger so that we won't die.' <u>God saw what they did</u>. He saw that they turned from their wicked ways. So God <u>reconsidered his threat to destroy them, and he didn't do it.</u>" Jonah 3:5-10 (GW)

"Warn each other every day, while it is still 'today', <u>so that none of you will be</u> <u>deceived by sin and hardened against God</u>. For if we are faithful to the end, trusting God just as firmly as when we first believed, we will share in all that

belongs to Christ . . . When you hear his voice, don't harden your hearts as Israel did when they rebelled." Hebrews 3:13-15 (NLT)

### **5 MISTAKES THAT MADE JONAH MISERABLE**

These make us miserable too

- 1. Jonah thought he could ignore his mission. He ran from God.
- 2. Jonah was prejudiced against people God created & loved.
- 3. Jonah cared more about his politics than people's salvation.
- 4. Jonah was only interested in his nation, not God's world.
- 5. Jonah reluctantly fulfilled his Mission, but with a bad attitude.

### 2 MORE MISTAKES: JONAH 4:1-11

1.

"When God saw that the people had stopped doing evil things, he had pity and <u>did not destroy them</u> as he had planned. <u>Jonah was really upset and angry</u>. So he prayed." Jonah 3:10-4:2 (CEV)

- \_\_\_\_\_ "It is better for me to die than live" Jonah 4:3 (NCV)

• \_\_\_\_\_ "Lord, please kill me!" Jonah 4:3 (NCV)

"He complained to the Lord about it: 'Didn't <u>I say before I left home</u> that you would do this, Lord? <u>That is why I ran away to Tarshish!</u> <u>I knew</u> that you are a <u>merciful</u> <u>and compassionate</u> God, <u>slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love</u>. You are eager to turn back from destroying people." Jonah 4:2 (NLT)

### WHAT TO REMEMBER WHEN THINGS DON'T GO MY WAY

#### 1. REMEMBER

2.

"Then Lord replied, 'What right do you have to be?" Jonah 4:4 (CEV)

"<u>Who are you to question my wisdom</u>? . . . Were you there when I made the world?" Job 38:2-4 (GNT)

"Then Jonah went out to the east side of the city and made a shelter to sit under <u>as he waited to see what would happen to the city</u>." Jonah 4:5 (NLT)

#### 2. REMEMBER

"The Lord <u>God arranged</u> for a leafy plant to grow there, and soon it spread its broad leaves over Jonah's head, <u>shading him</u> from the sun. <u>This eased his</u> <u>discomfort</u>, and Jonah was very grateful for the plant." Jonah 4:6 (NLT)

#### 3. REMEMBER

"But then <u>God sent a worm</u>. By dawn of the next day, the worm had bored into the shade tree and it withered away. The sun came up and <u>God sent</u> a hot, blistering wind from the east. The sun beat down on Jonah's head and he started to faint. He prayed to die: 'I'm better off dead!'" Jonah 4:7-8 (MSG)

"Then God said to Jonah, '<u>Is it right</u> for you to be angry because the plant died?' 'Yes," Jonah retorted, 'even angry enough to die!'" Jonah 4:9 (MSG)

### 4. REMEMBER

And the Lord said, 'You are <u>so concerned</u> for that plant even though you did nothing to make it grow. It appeared one day, and <u>the next day it died</u>. Then <u>shouldn't I show concern for the great city</u> Nineveh, which has more than one hundred twenty thousand people who do not know right from wrong, and many animals, too?''' Jonah 4:10-11 (NCV)
