"Daniel went at once to see the king and requested more time to tell the king what the dream meant." Daniel 2:16 (NLT)

4. _____
"Then Daniel went home and told his friends Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah what had happened. He urged them to ask the God of heaven to show them his mercy by telling them the secret, so they would not be executed." Daniel 2:17-18 (NLT)

God: "Call to me and I will answer you. I'll tell you marvelous and wondrous things that you could never figure out on your own." Jeremiah 33:3 (MSG)

God also told this secret to me, not because I have greater wisdom than any other living person, but so that you may know what it means." Daniel 2:27-30 (NCV)
