DANIEL'S FIRST TEST SHOWS **4 QUALITIES GOD LOOKS FOR IN YOUR LIFE**

1.

"Daniel resolved not to defile himself." Daniel 1:8 (NIV)

"Do not conform vourselves to the standards of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind. Then you will be able to know the will of God." Romans 12:2 (GNT)

2.

"Daniel made up his mind <u>not to eat</u> the food and wine given to them by the king." Daniel 1:8 (TLB)

"Do not let any part of your bodies become tools of wickedness, to be used for sinning; but give yourselves completely to God . . . and you want to be tools in the hands of God, to be used for his good purposes." Romans 6:13 (TLB)

"Don't join mobs intent on evil. When on the witness stand, don't be swayed in your testimony by the mood of the majority." Exodus 23:2 (TLB) "Stand firm in the faith. Be courageous. Be strong." 1 Corinthians 16:13 (NLT)

"He asked the superintendent for permission to eat other things instead. Now as it happened. God had given the superintendent a special appreciation for Daniel and sympathy for his predicament. But he was alarmed by Daniel's suggestion. 'I'm afraid you will become pale and thin compared with the other youths your age.' he said, 'and then the king will behead me for neglecting my responsibilities.' Daniel talked it over with the steward who was appointed by the superintendent to look after Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, and suggested a ten-day diet of only vegetables and water; then, at the end . . . decide whether or not to let them continue their diet. The steward finally agreed to the test. Well, at the end of the ten days, Daniel and his three friends looked healthier and better nourished than the youths who had been eating the food supplied by the king! So after that the steward fed them only vegetables and water, without the rich foods and wines! . . . When the three-year training period was completed, the superintendent brought all the young men to the king for oral exams, as he had been ordered to do. King Nebuchadnezzar had long talks with each of them, and none of them impressed him as much as Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. So they were put on his regular staff of advisors." Daniel 1:8-16, 18-19 (TLB)

HOW TO MAKE A CASE TO AN AUTHORITY



WHAT GAVE DANIEL THE COURAGE TO STAND ALONE?

"Don't become partners with those who reject God. How can you make a partnership out of right and wrong? That's not partnership; that's war. Is light best friends with dark? Does Christ go strolling with the Devil? Do trust and mistrust hold hands? Who would think of setting up pagan idols in God's holy Temple? But that is exactly what we are, each of us a temple in whom God lives. God himself put it this way: 'I'll live in them, move into them; I'll be their God and they'll be my people. So leave the corruption and compromise. . . . <u>I'll be a Father to you; you'll be sons and daughters</u> to me.' The Word of the Master, God. DANIEL'S THIRD TEST: CHALLENGES TO HIS FAITH

"King Nebuchadnezzar wanted only young Israelite men . . . They were to be handsome and well educated, capable of learning. . . . Teach them <u>the language and writings of the Babylonians</u> . . . the young men were to be trained for three years, and then they would become servants of the king of Babylon." Daniel 1:4-5 (NCV)

"God gave these four young men wisdom and the <u>ability to learn many things that</u> <u>people had written and studied</u>." Daniel 1:17 (NCV)

"When the three-year training period was completed, the superintendent brought all the young men to the king for oral exams, as he had been ordered to do. King Nebuchadnezzar had long talks with each of them, and none of them impressed him as much as Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. So they were put on his regular staff of advisors. And in all matters requiring <u>information and balanced judgment</u>, the king found these young men's advice <u>ten times better</u> than that of <u>all the</u> skilled magicians and wise astrologers in his realm." Daniel 1:18-20 (TLB)

"Daniel <u>went at once</u> to see the king and <u>requested more time</u> to tell the king what the dream meant." Daniel 2:16 (NLT)

"Then Daniel went home and told his friends Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah what had happened. He urged them to <u>ask the God of heaven to show them his mercy</u> by telling them the secret, so they would not be executed." Daniel 2:17-18 (NLT)

Then the princes, governors, captains, and counselors crowded around them and saw that the fire hadn't touched them-not a hair of their heads was singed; their coats were unscorched, and they didn't even smell of smoke!" WE GET BETTER WHEN WE REPLACE _____ WITH

"Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years. . . . To humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart. whether or not you would keep his commands. He humbled you, causing you to hunger. . . . The Lord your God is bringing you into a good land-a land with brooks, streams, and deep springs. . . . a land with wheat and barley, vines and fig trees, pomegranates, olive oil and honey . . . a land where the rocks are iron and you can dig copper out of the hills. . . . When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the Lord your God for the good land he has given you. Be careful that you do not forget the Lord your God, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day. Otherwise, when you eat and are satisfied, when you build fine houses and settle down, and when your herds and flocks grow large and your silver and gold increase and all you have is multiplied, then your heart will become proud and you will forget the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. . . . You may say to yourself. 'My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me.' But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth. . . .
